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Heart Failure is emerging as a public health problem in the country. The three-year mortality of 45% as reported in the Trivandrum HF registry is higher than many common cancers.

The registry data has shown us that guideline directed therapy is prescribed only to 25-40% of patients with heart failure, indicating that there is a significant scope for quality improvement initiatives among the treating physicians.
