

Prof. Andrew JS Coats, MA (Oxon) MB B Chir (Cantab) DM (Oxon), DSc FRACP, FRCP, FESC, FAHA, FHFA, FCSANZ, FAICD, MIOD, MBA

Prof Coats has been Joint Academic Vice-President, University of Warwick, UK and Monash University, Australia since 2012 leading the Monash-Warwick Alliance. Prof. Coats specializes in heart failure and hypertension. He has in excess of 1500 publications, more than 57,000

career citations, and a personal H-index of 107 to his credit. He has been Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Cardiology since 1999. He has been Chairman or Committee member of the following major Cardio-metabolic trials: CHRISTMAS, CHARM, COPERNICUS, OXAM, OPTIMAAL, OVERTURE, REPLACE, ACT-ONE and SENIORS.



Prof. Piotr Ponikowski.

Professor Ponikowski is the present Head of the Department of Cardiology, Centre for Heart Diseases, Military Hospital and Head of the Department of Heart Diseases, Medical University, Wroclaw, Poland. He is the current President Elect of the Polish Cardiac Society. He was the President of the Heart Failure Association of the ESC (2010-2012) and currently is a Chair of the 2016 ESC Heart

Failure Guidelines. His primary research interest is heart failure, including cardio respiratory reflex control, neurohormonal mechanisms in acute heart failure. Prof. Ponikowski has been the main investigator for numerous clinical trials, a member of international steering committees, endpoint committees, and advisory boards. Prof. Ponikowski is a reviewer and editorial board member for several leading cardiovascular journals, he has published over 450 peer-reviewed papers, book chapters, and review articles that are well-cited (H-index: 73).



Prof. Stefan D. Anker, MD, PhD, FESC.

Dr. Stefan D. Anker is at present, Professor of Innovative Clinical Trials at University Medical Center Göttingen.. Dr. Anker is Councilor of the Board European Society of Cardiology (ESC, 2014-16). Dr. Anker is in the board of the Heart Failure Association (HFA) of the ESC since 2006. He was HFA President (2012-14), and currently

chairs the HFA committee on regulatory affairs. Dr. Anker is founding Editor-in-Chief of the first open access heart failure journal ESC Heart Failure. Dr. Anker serves on the editorial boards of 5 scientific journals (including European Heart Journal, European Journal of Heart Failure & International Journal of Cardiology). Dr. Anker is the founding president of the International Society on Sarcopenia, Cachexia and Wasting Disorders (SCWD) and the founding Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Cachexia, Sarcopenia and Muscle.

Dr. Anker has authored more than 600 original papers, reviews, and editorials that are well cited (total citations: >36,000, h-index: 96)

Prof. Inder S. Anand, MBBS, FRCP, FACC, D Phil (Oxon.)



Dr. Inder Anand is Professor of Medicine, University of Minnesota, and was the Director of the Heart Failure Program at the VA Medical Center in Minneapolis till December 2014. Dr. Anand has made seminal contributions to the field of heart failure with salt and water retention theory, discovered two new syndromes in people living at high altitude; Infantile sub-acute mountain sickness and Sub-acute adult mountain sickness. He pioneered the use of inhaled NO in the management of high altitude pulmonary edema.

He has been a principal investigator in over 80 heart failure clinical trials, and member of executive, steering and end-point committees of several international multicenter clinical trials. He is member of the editorial board of several Journals and has authored over 350 peer-reviewed scientific publications, over 600 abstracts and has over 5,000citations of his published work.



Dr. Stephsn Von Haehling, MD PhD DIC FESC.

Dr. Von Heahling is a consultant cardiologist and Associate Professor of Medicine at the Department of Cardiology and Pneumology at the University Medical Center Göttingen, Germany. Dr. Von Haehling has authored more than 230 original research papers, review articles, and editorials and serves on several editorial boards, including Journal of Cachexia, Sarcopenia and Muscle, ESC Heart Failure, International Journal of Cardiology, Clinical Science,

Expert Opinion on Investigational Drugs, Cardiology Research and Practice, and Archives of Medical Science. He has been Principal Investigator in a number of large-scale clinical trials. His research interests include the pathophysiology of heart failure, muscle wasting, biomarkers, and novel treatments.
