About the Programme

Heart Failure is emerging as a public health problem in the country. The three - year mortality of 45% as reported in the Trivandrum HF registry is higher than many common cancers. The registry data has shown us that guideline directed therapy is prescribed only to 25 – 40% of patients with heart failure, indicating that there is a significant scope for quality improvement initiatives among the treating healthcare professionals.

One of the ways is to have continuing educational programs to increase the awareness about the disease burden and the importance of evidence-based therapy.

In view of these, HFAI in collaboration with Trained Nurse's Association of India has decided to conduct an online course on heart failure with the country's leading HF specialists joining in as faculty.
